Purpose of this manual






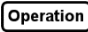

This manual explains operation of Mac OS device.

1.1 Overview


Optimal Biz (hereinafter referred to as this product) is a support service that manages and operates Mac OS devices without requiring expert knowledge. Remote lock and remote wipe (initialization) of Mac OS devices can be performed from Optimal Biz management site. (hereinafter referred to as the management site).

 This manual is the operation manual of Mac OS devices. For operation of the management site, refer to the following.

1.2 OS support policy

In this product, OS support policy was established with the aim of ensuring product operation and security functions. We will end support of lower OS version on a regular basis, so customers who use OS and devices that are not subject to support will be requested to update OS or change model.

1.4 Profile


To use this product on Mac OS, you have to install profiles on your devices.

<<Function of profile>>

General	Function
Retrieve Mac OS device information	Retrieve Mac OS device information regularly and send it to the server.
Set Mac OS device	Get the setting information from the server and apply the setting to Mac OS device.

1.5 Limitations

Be aware of the following limitations when using this product.

-  Network information displayed under the "Info" tab on the "Asset" page only displays information about the standard on-board network card on a Mac OS device.

You can manage the Mac OS device by installing the profile on the device.

3.1 Register Asset Information

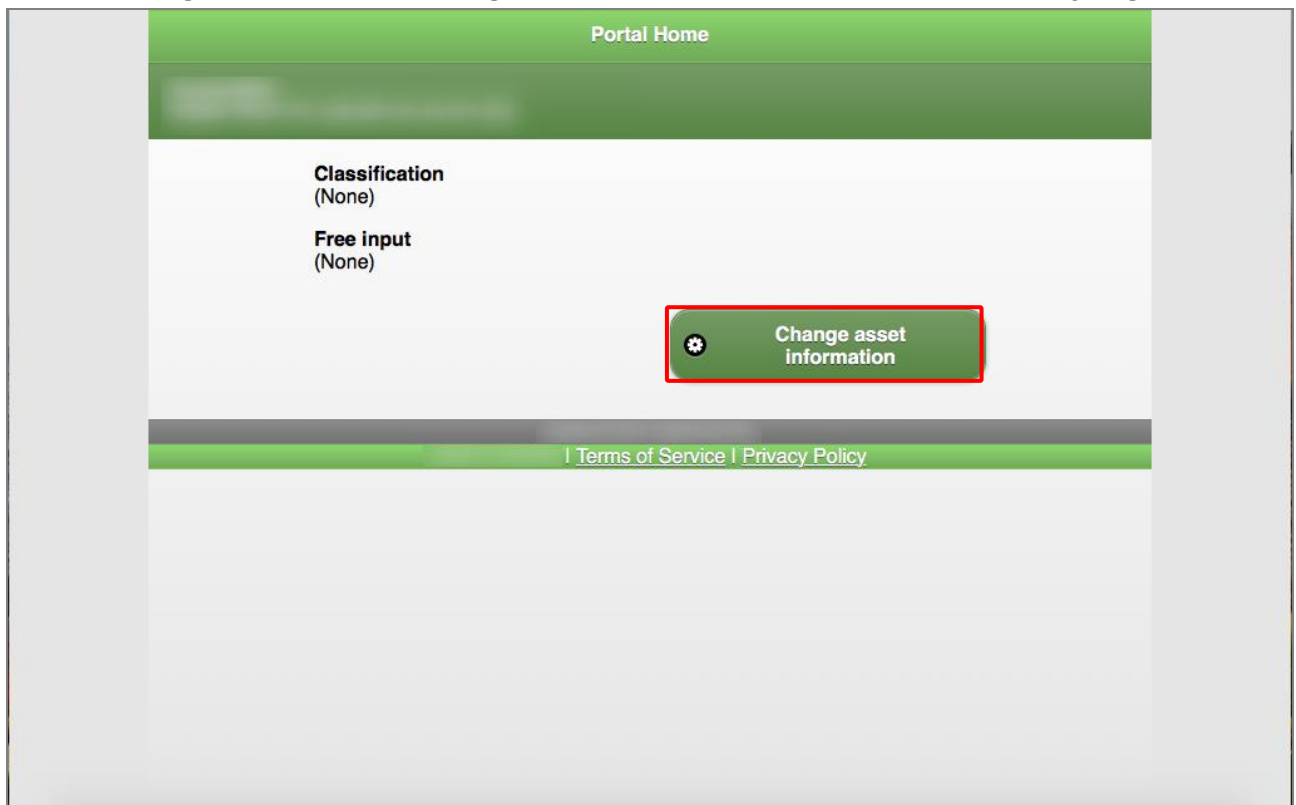
If you want to change your device information or if you did not register any device information when you installed a profile, follow the steps below to change it.

☑ If an additional asset Item is not registered on the management site, the setting page is not displayed. An asset item depends on the settings on the management site.

- [1]** Click on the [Portal] icon displayed on the Dock(Menu bar displayed at the bottom or side of Macscreen).

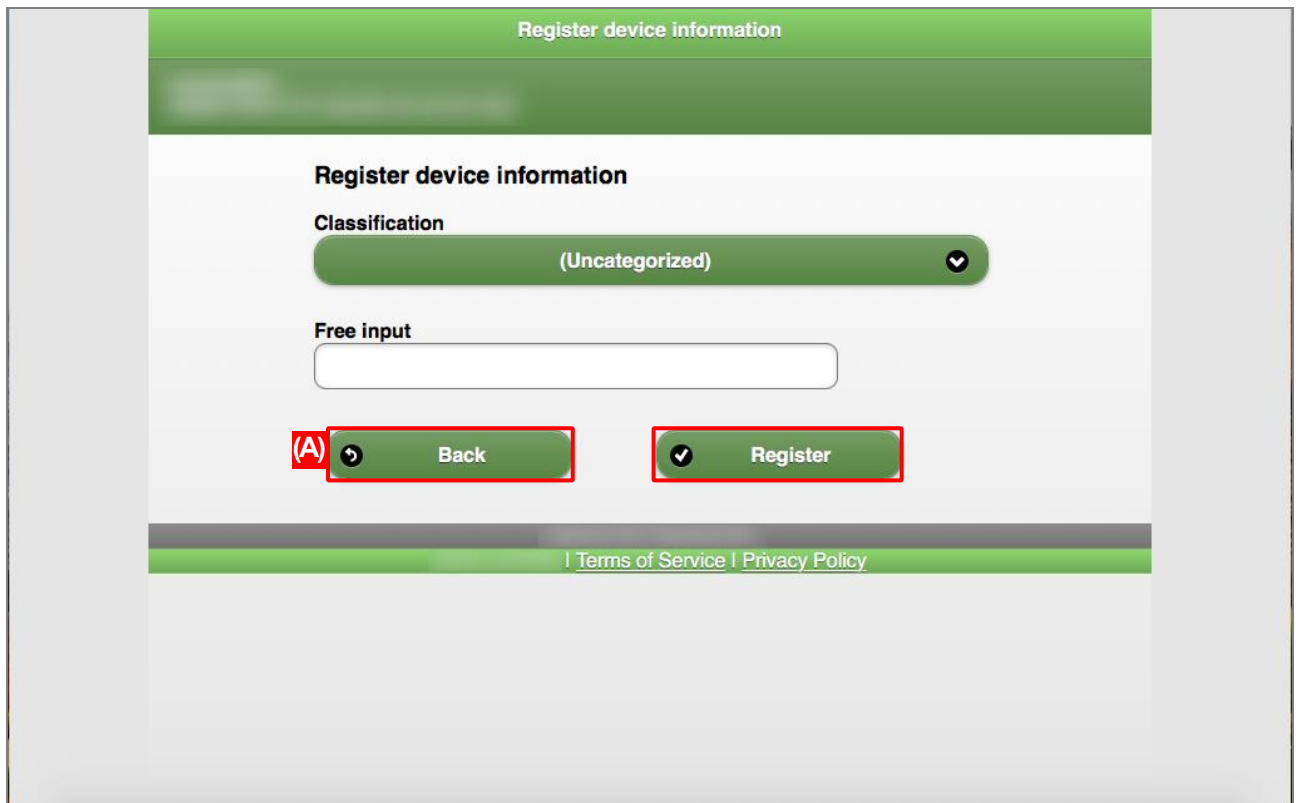


- [2]** The portal page opens. Click [Change asset information] if the asset is already registered.



[3] Click [Register].

✎ Click [Back] (A) to display the previous page.

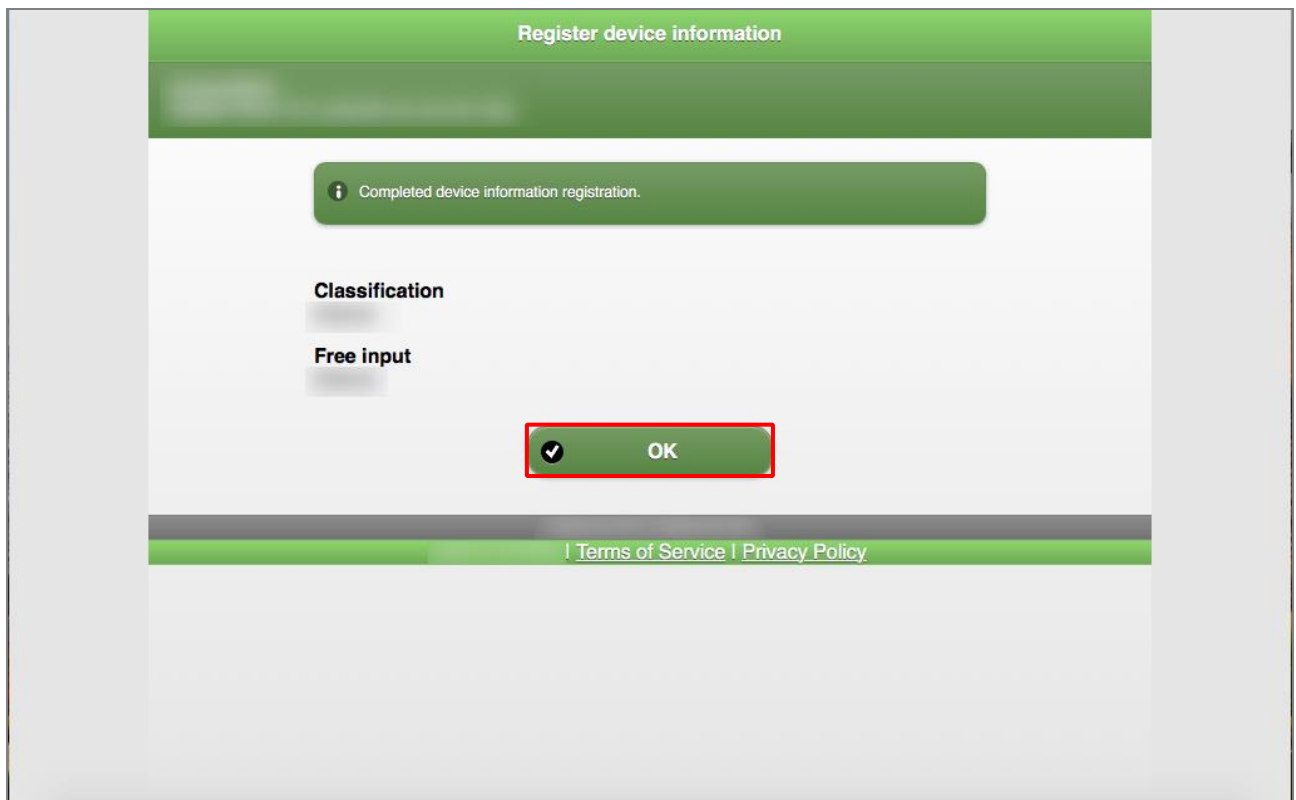

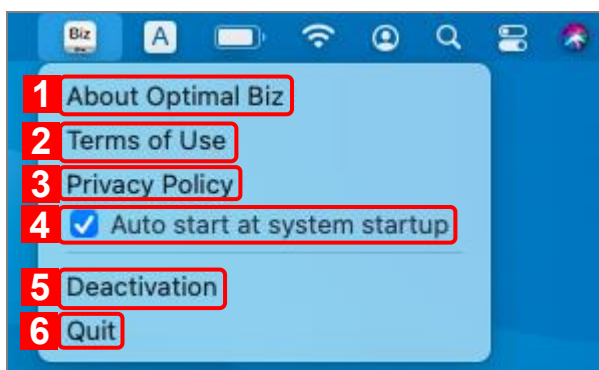

6	Quit	Quit the agent.

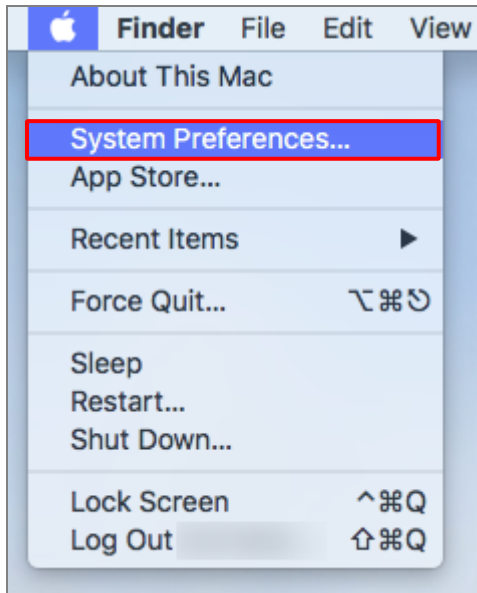

Follow the steps below to uninstall a profile of this product.

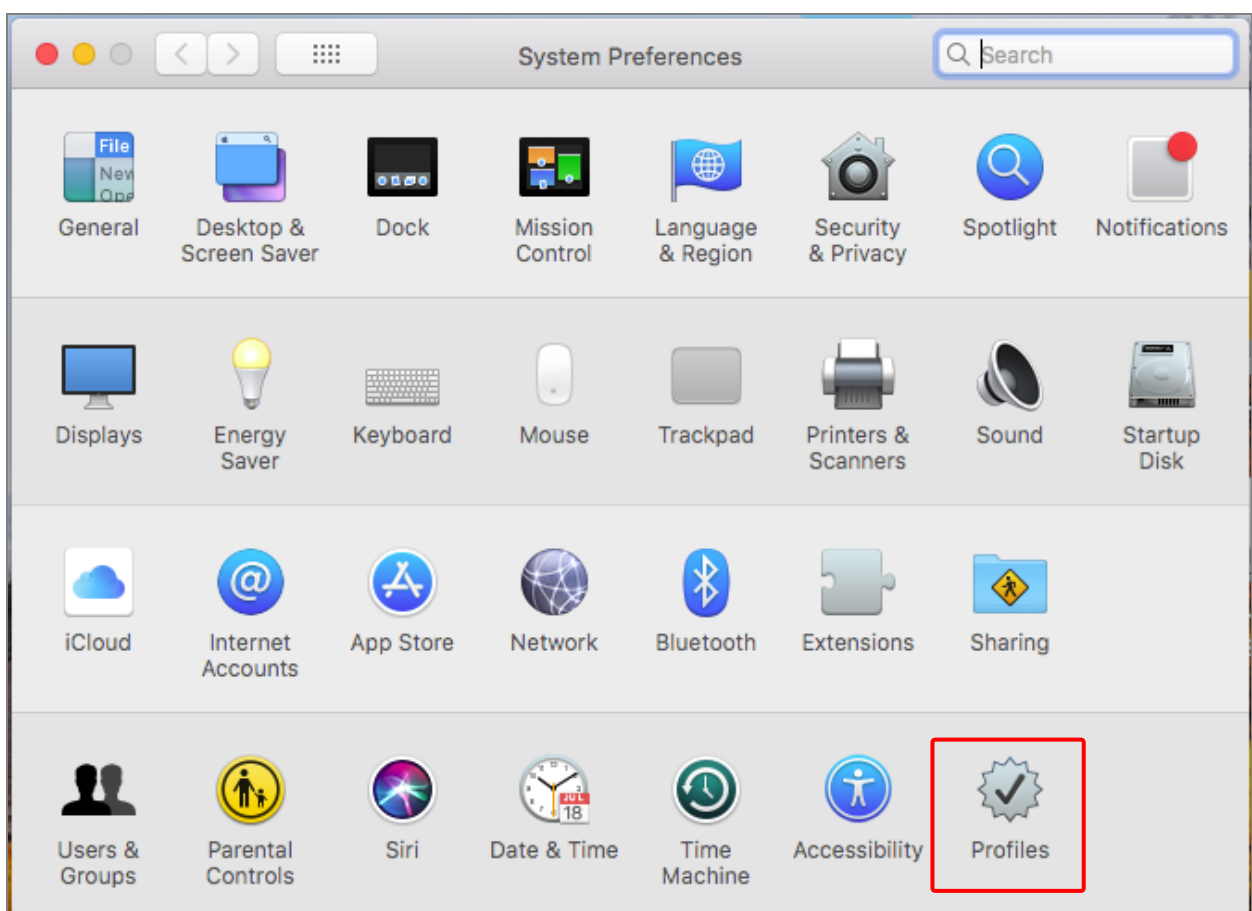
[1] Click .

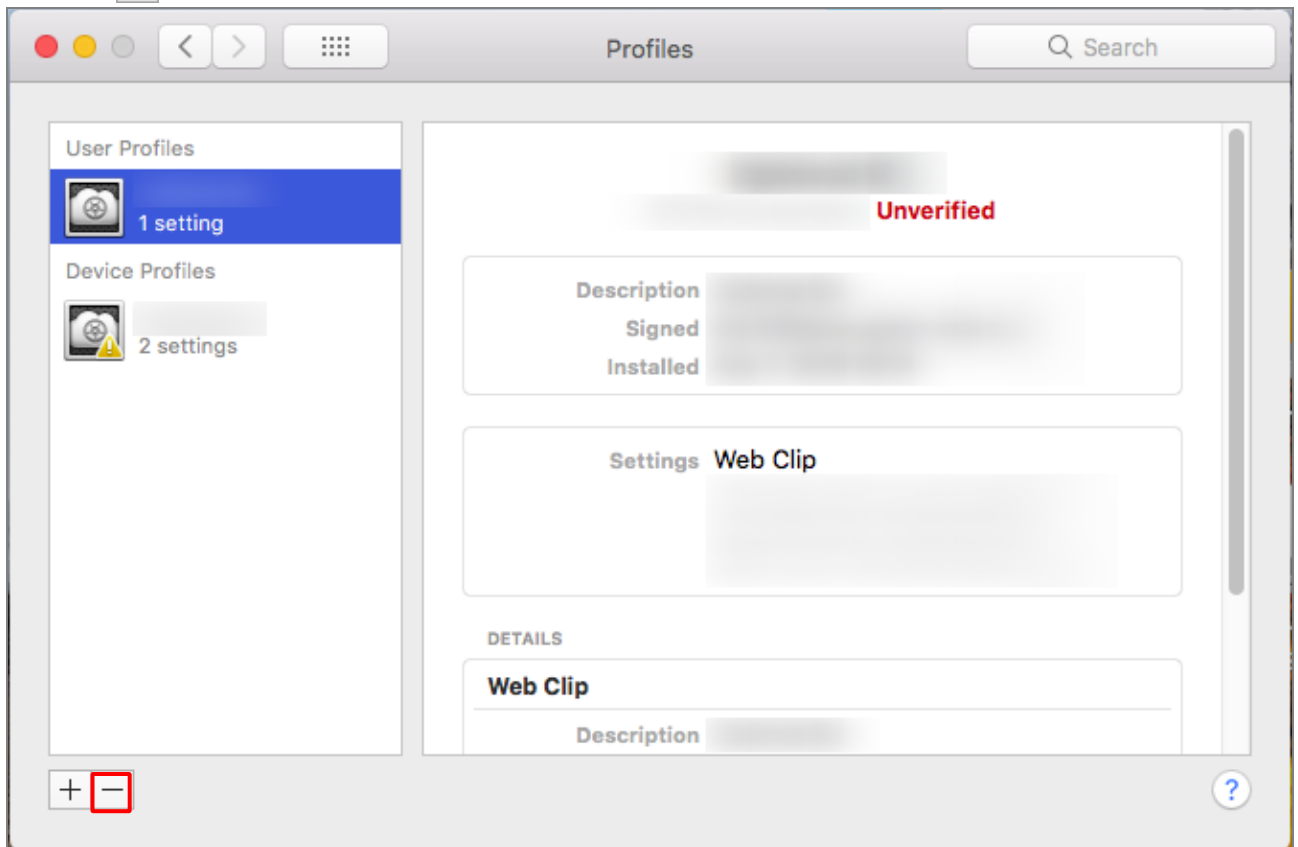
⇒ Click "System Preferences".



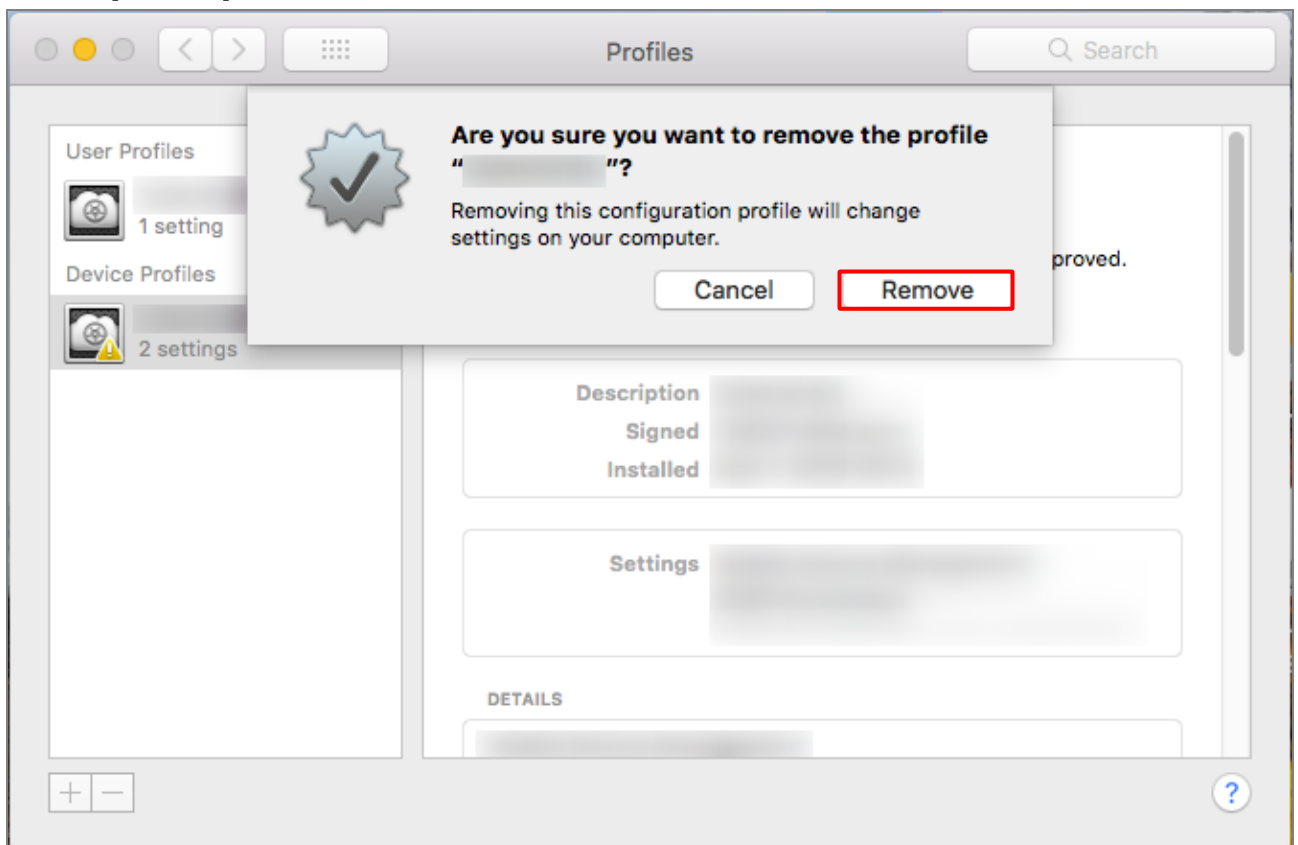
[2] Choose "Profiles" from "System Preferences".

⇒ The "Profile" icon will not be available under "System Preferences" if no configuration profiles are installed.



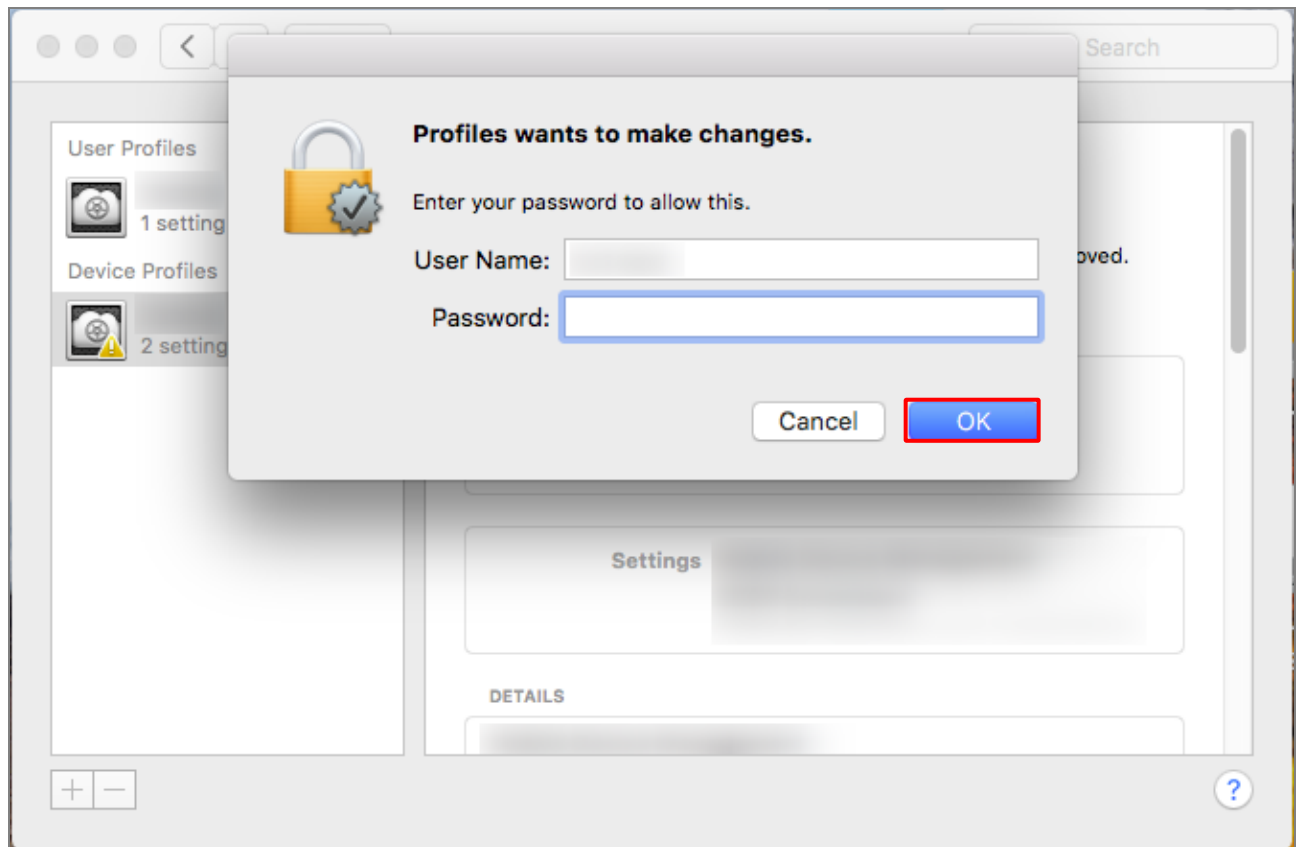
[3] Select the target profiles from the "Profiles" list.⇒ Click .**[4] confirmation message box is displayed.**

⇒ Click [Remove].



[5] A password is requested by the system setting.

⇒ Enter the password and press [OK].

**[6] If you are registering to Dock delete the portal icon of Dock.**

⇒ Even if you delete a profile from Mac, the portal icon of Dock will not be deleted automatically.

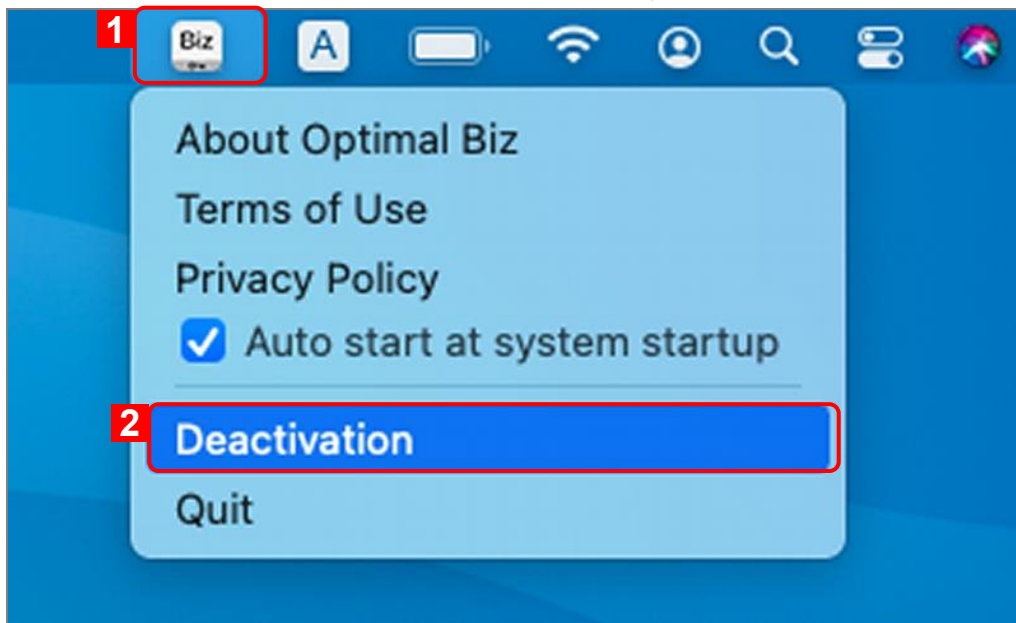
7.1 Deactivating the Agent

Use the following procedures to deactivate the agent.

[1] Click  that appears in the menu bar.

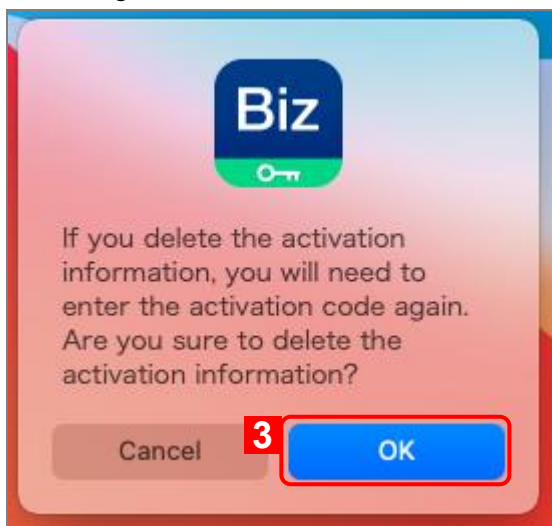
[2] Click [Deactivation].

⇒ The confirmation screen for deactivation is displayed.




[3] Click [OK].

⇒ The agent will be deactivated, and the authentication screen is displayed again.



[4] Click  to close the screen.

 The icon that was displayed in the menu bar will no longer be displayed.
